Winning classic races and becoming a champion is passed down from generation to generation in this colt. His sire, Point Given, is a champion; his grandsire, Thunder Gulch, is a champion, and his great grand sire, Gulch, was a champion.

Mojo Trainer, JR Caldwell purchased this colt because of his bloodline and physique. "He's a sturdy, good looking horse that has the pedigree to carry a route of ground," JR explains. "I can see him developing into successful runner at a mile or more. And, with the dam's linage racing in England, this horse could turn out to be dominant on the turf as a three-year-old."

Based on his pedigree nicking pattern, 67% of the colts on this cross have gone on to be winners earning over \$2.2 Million.

Point Given is 2001 Eclipse Champion 3 YO Colt & Horse of the Year. He is the only horse in history to have won four \$1 Million races in a row: the Preakness, the Belmont, the Haskell Invitational, and the Travers.

45% of Point Given's offspring are winners, and he has produced two champions, seven graded stakes winners, 17 stakes winners, and 18 stakes place finishers.

Auspice is the dam of six foals, one is a stakes winner. She comes from a family of stakes winners that stems back to the prominent Nasrullah bloodline.
